









Overview

- Assaults are on the rise






Incidents by Type






Metrobus Service Area






District of Columbia






Maryland – Montgomery County






Maryland – Prince George's County

Current and Future Initiatives

- On-going Initiatives
 - High Intensity Targeted Enforcement (HITE) consisting of MTP plain clothes officers riding routes with high incident rates.
 - Bus operator contact cards records MTPD daily contacts with bus operators.
 - Improved communication between bus operators and MTP with contact cards and compliant forms.
 - MTP attend all bus division safety meetings to share information.
 - DC Legislation Bill No. 17-233 "Transit Operator Protection and Enhanced Penalty Act of 2007".
- Future Initiatives
 - Exploring feasibility of installing a pilot program for bus operator shields.
 - Increase staffing of plain clothes officers on buses as the MTP vacancy rate decreases.
