PURPOSE

To present the Board of Directors with an analysis of cost savings associated with the reduction-in-force.

DESCRIPTION

The reduction-in-force was designed to eliminate 254 positions in three phases by FY09. Phases I and II eliminated a total of 240 positions.

NEXT STEPS

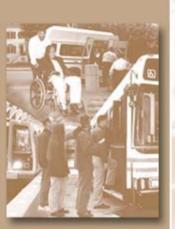
Phase III will eliminate an additional 14 positions by June 2008.

Background

- Shift in corporate focus from construction to maintenance and operation of existing system
- Construction staff reduced as projects/programs are completed

 Reduction in force executed in accordance with Organizational Assessment

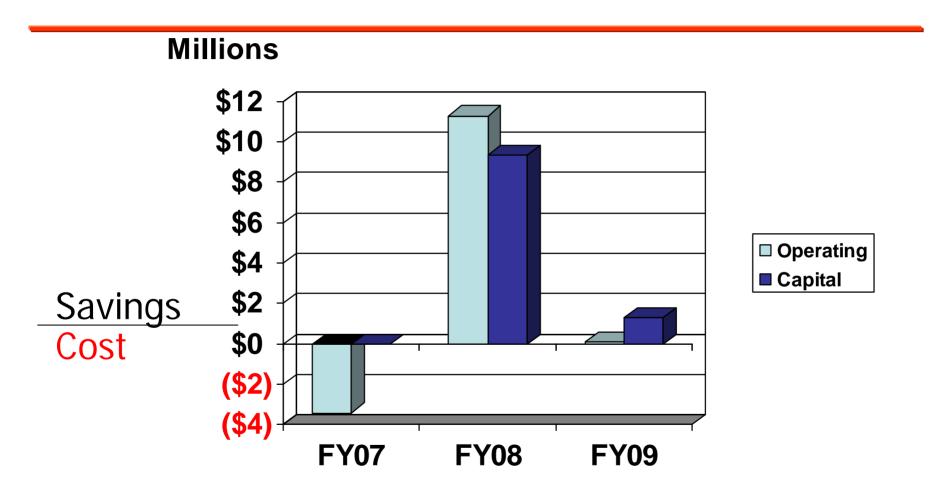


Summary

- 254 positions to be eliminated in three phases by FY09
- Phase I 217 positions eliminated effective July 2007 (severance cost expensed in FY07 budget)
- Phase II 23 positions eliminated effective February 2008 (FY08 impact will be approximately 40% of annual salary due to midyear reduction)
- Phase III 14 positions to be eliminated effective June 2008

Savings continue in subsequent fiscal years
