#### TITLE:

Amend budget to include surveillance cameras

#### **PURPOSE:**

To obtain Finance, Administration and Oversight Committee concurrence and Board approval to: (1) amend the FY 2009 Budget to include \$275,000 for installation of surveillance cameras at 12 Metrorail stations; (2) issue billings to the District of Columbia for \$200,000 and to Fairfax County for \$75,000; and (3) initiate and award a new contract or modify an existing contract to install and maintain surveillance cameras and viewing systems at 10 Metrorail stations in the District of Columbia and at 2 Metrorail stations in Fairfax County, Virginia.

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

In July of 2008, the Metro Transit Police Department conducted an Emergency Management Program Presentation, which identified jurisdictional camera information. The presentation listed Metrorail stations within all jurisdictions that require surveillance cameras be installed.

Cameras will be installed overlooking the stations and areas surrounding the station entrances. Viewing systems, including digital video recorders and monitors, will be installed within the station facility for the purpose of observation and recording under the supervision of the Metro Transit Police Department.

Cameras will be installed at the following locations in the District of Columbia:

Rhode Island Ave-Brentwood
Congress Heights
Deanwood
Minnesota Ave
Fort Totten
Takoma
Brookland-CUA
Columbia Heights
Georgia Ave-Petworth
Tenleytown-AU

Cameras will be installed at the following locations in Fairfax County:

Vienna/Fairfax-GMU Franconia-Springfield

### **PURPOSE**

Approval to amend the FY 2009 Capital Budget to include \$275,000 for installation of surveillance cameras at 12 Metrorail stations.



### **BACKGROUND**

- On July 10, 2008, MTPD presented to the Board, WMATA's Emergency Management Program and jurisdictional camera information.
- MTPD identified the top ten Metrorail stations for cameras in District of Columbia, Maryland and Virginia.
- The District of Columbia has set aside \$200,000 in their
   FY 2009 budget to fund the installation of cameras at 10 Metrorail stations in the District of Columbia.
- Fairfax County is making available \$75,000 from the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC) to pay for the cameras.



### RECOMMENDATIONS

### Approval to:

- Amend the FY 2009 Capital Budget to include \$275,000 for installation of surveillance cameras at 12 Metrorail stations;
- Authorize billings to the District of Columbia for \$200,000 and to Fairfax County through the NVTC for \$75,000; and
