Significant Facts

- **The probability of being a victim of a Part I crime in the Metro system is 2.74 per million customers.**
- In 2008, the MTPD received 50,479 calls for service, made 1,499 arrests, issued 5,385 criminal/civil citations and wrote 2,424 fare evasion citations.



Significant Facts

The probability of becoming a victim of serious crime is significantly higher in the communities serviced by Metro than in the Metro system itself.
