SUBJECT: INAUGURATION DAY WEEKEND SERVICE LEVELS, FARES AND PASSES

PROPOSED RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, On January 20, 2009, Barack Obama will be inaugurated as the 44th President of the United States with events starting on January 17, 2009 and continuing through January 20, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Staff expects unprecedented demand for parking during the events surrounding the 2009 Presidential Inauguration on days when there is traditionally no charge for parking but for which a charge is authorized; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, In accordance with the Board of Director's action in Resolution No. 81-14, the General Manager is authorized to determine the level of service provided from January 17, 2009 through January 20, 2009 and to charge peak level fares, as appropriate, based on projected demand; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the charge for parking at Metrorail lots on Inauguration Day, January 20, 2009, shall be established by the General Manager but shall not exceed the established rates for parking at the various lots;

RESOLVED, That the General Manager is authorized to establish a day pass for Inauguration day service which shall be sold for \$10; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
