##00250 PRE-PROPOSAL/PRE-BID MEETINGS SCHEDULE##

- A. The pre-proposal conference will be held at 10:00 AM EST on Wednesday, May 3, 2017, in the Jackson Graham Building-JGB, Lobby conference room of the WMATA, 600 5th Street, NW, Washington, DC 20001. This conference is being conjured to gain all the prospective Offerors understanding of the RFP packages and as added assurance that all offerors propose with the same understanding of all conditions of the contract including conditions at the sites. It is requested that Offerors submit their questions in writing well in advance of the pre-proposal confab or during the confab. Questions from the floor, however, are permissible.

All questions concerning the terms, conditions, and requirements of this Request for Proposals must be received by the Contracting Officer in writing within fourteen (14) calendar days before the proposal due date.

00260 PRE-AWARD MEETING

- A. The Authority requires that a pre-award meeting with the successful Proposer/Bidder be held prior to the actual award of the Contract. The purpose of the meeting will be to review the successful Proposer's/Bidder's understanding of the Contract Documents, contractual requirements prior to award, and to confirm the successful Proposer's/Bidder's capabilities, financial standing, and past experience.
- B. The pre-award meeting will be held in the Washington Metropolitan area and shall be chaired by the Authority and attended by representatives of the Authority, the successful Proposer/Bidder and its Key Staff nominated for assignment to the Contract, and major Subcontractors if so requested by the Authority. Concerned parties shall each be represented by persons thoroughly familiar with and authorized to conclude matters relating to the Work described in the RFP/IFB Documents.
- C. Agenda discussion items for the meeting may include, but are not limited to, the following:
2. Requirements for acceptability of payment and performance bonds.
 3. Requirements for DBE participation.
 4. Requirements for quality assurance/quality control.

- B. Unless otherwise provided in the Contract Documents the Awardee will be required to perform any and all activities necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work
- C. At any given time, the Contractor is expected to be joint scoping, developing Cost Proposals, and performing work in the field at multiple Project Sites all concurrently.
- D. The base contract will be for a maximum total ordering period of five (5) years. The Ordering Period of five(5) years establishes limits for the issuance of Individual Task Order. Actual performance period for completion of work included in Individual Task Orders may extend beyond contract ordering period date.
- E. The guaranteed minimum for this contract is \$25,000 per contract, over the full life of the contract, which is five (5) years. Task Orders will be firm fixed price and will be predominately in dollar value from \$150,000 to \$3,000,000; however, the Authority may elect to issue task orders of a higher value, but no less than \$150,000.
- F. The estimated aggregate value for all awarded contracts is between \$50,000,000 and \$175,000,000.
- G. Under the terms of the Contract, the Awardee shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools, supervision, project management, quality control, testing, transportation, safety, appurtenances, and other items necessary for the successful completion of each awarded task order. Each completed project will result in the complete construction, testing, and commissioning of the Authority facilities as specified in each task order and the general contract terms.
- H. The Awardee shall obtain necessary permits, and work as necessary, perform systems integration work, manage quality through the use of an effective and well-planned quality system.
- I. Unless specifically stated otherwise, all work shall conform to the respective construction standards and specifications of the jurisdiction having authority or the Authority. If/where no such standards and/or specifications exist, the work shall be performed in accordance with the applicable prevailing industry standards.
- Q. Each project shall function as an integral part of and be fully compatible with the existing WMATA system.
