- 4. The Authority may in its sole discretion accept a late proposal in instances where it is clear that the proposal left the hands of the proposer before the time set for receipt of proposals and acceptance of the late proposal will not delay the procurement or prejudice the other proposers.
- Notwithstanding these requirements, a late modification of any otherwise successful offer that makes its terms more favorable to the Authority will be considered at any time it is received and may be accepted.

## J. #Proposal Guarantee: Not Applicable

- A proposal guarantee is required by the Request for Proposal.
