14. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND BASIS FOR AWARD (the word highlighted in Yellow is added) (Page 12 of the RFP)

TECHNICALLY ACCEPTABLE - LOW PRICE

(a) The Authority will award a Contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror(s) whose proposal conforms to the solicitation and is determined to be the lowest priced among those proposals rated "technically acceptable." For purposes of determining whether a proposal is "technically acceptable" for purposes of this solicitation, the following Criteria for Acceptability shall apply:

EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL PROPOSALS: Each offeror's technical proposal will be evaluated against the following evaluation criteria in order to be determined "technically acceptable". Each technical proposal shall be so specific, detailed, and complete as to clearly and fully demonstrate that the perspective contractor has a thorough knowledge and understanding of the requirements and has valid and practical solutions for technical problems. Statements which paraphrase the specifications or attest that "standard procedures will be employed" are inadequate to demonstrate how it is proposed to comply with the requirements of the specifications, and this clause. As a minimum, the proposal must clearly provide the following information in the order in which requested:

NOTE: Offeror must address each of the following areas and include all required submittals and exhibits along with the Technical Proposal. Failure to provide information requested herewith will result in proposals being "Technically Unacceptable".

JGB Service Calls: During the contract year ending June 30, 2016, approximately 10,300 contractor man-hours were expended to complete approximately 3433 service related functions. These hours are in addition to scheduled work (facilities requests) and the performance of preventive maintenance. The noted hours are for estimating purposes only; and may not represent actual requirements during this contract.

VII. Critical Building Functions, Building Mechanical Equipment Operation and Maintenance (Page Stone straw 3 Of the RFP):

SS Service Calls: During the contract year ending June 30, 2016, approximately 542 contractor manhours were expended to complete approximately 181 service related functions. These hours are in addition to scheduled work (facilities requests) and the performance of preventive maintenance.
