CQ18106 RISK MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (RMIS) QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM VENDORS AND WMATA'S RESPONSE

Vendor's question:

The efforts to import PeopleSoft, Safety Management Software, Excel Spreadsheets, Policy files, Peoplesoft employee, work attendance, Third Party administrator data requires each system's file structure. To offer a finite price without setting limited import criteria the structure is necessary.

Are the 2,000 existing video attachments are to be imported also? If so how are they to be attached to the existed file records? In other words, will a log and destination syllabus be supplied?

WMATA's response:

WMATA expects the vendors to provide pricing based on their experience/expectations interfacing with the sources listed as well as their understanding of the functional and technical requirements/specifications (section 3.3 & 3.4 of the RFP). As such, the requested information regarding the file structure cannot be provided at this stage.

With regard to the question concerning existing videos, per 3.3.3.2 of the RFP which states:

"WMATA requires the transfer of historical third party incidents/claims and attachments from the TPA's claim system to the RMIS and continue the process within the RMIS going forward".

A log and destination syllabus will not be supplied.
